

**Instructions for Completing the "Course Selection Summary" Table:** To design your high school program, start with the Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements (see "High School Credit Checklist" below) and post-secondary requirements (see "Post-Secondary Requirements" below).

1. In the column "Post-Secondary Prerequisites" list the grade 12 prerequisites for the post-secondary program you are considering.
2. In the "Grade 12" column, list the courses you require for your post-secondary program, your elective and compulsory courses.
3. In the "Grade 11" column, list the prerequisite courses for the courses you have listed in the "Grade 12" column, your elective and compulsory courses.
4. In the "Grade 10" column, list the prerequisite courses for the courses you have written in the "Grade 11" column, your elective and compulsory courses.
5. In the "Grade 9" column, list the prerequisite courses for the courses you have written in the "Grade 10" column, your elective and compulsory courses
